- 10 to 15 Escrow Credits are awarded upon successful completion of AASN degree requirements and completion of the Credit by Examination form which includes payment of credit by examination fees with the exception of tuition.
- **Students may be enrolled in uncompleted pre-nursing courses at the time of application submission and ALL General Education required courses must be completed by the end of the semester prior to enrolling in the SECOND YEAR clinical nursing courses.**
- **First Year Seminar is required for all students with less than 15 College Credits.**
- Students apply for admission to LPN Validation courses by the third Friday in September for spring semester enrollment and by the third Friday in January for fall enrollment. General Education required courses must be completed by the end of the semester prior to enrolling in Validation courses. Application submission **does not** guarantee acceptance into LPN Validation courses.

Students submit a separate application for admission to nursing on or before the third Friday in September for spring semester or the third Friday in January for fall semester admission to clinical NURSING courses. Basic requirements for admission to the nursing program: course grades of C or better, science courses no older than seven years, cumulative UDC grade point average of 2.5 or better. Application submission **does not** guarantee admission to the nursing program. **See the back of this sheet for further information.**

Requirements: Meet the Pre-Nursing Requirements for the desired University (CUA, GU, HU, UDCCC)

Students planning to attend the UDCCC LPN to RN Program must follow the following guidelines:

1. Submit an Admission Application to the University of the District of Columbia Community College.
2. Submit a Validation Application by the **Third (3rd) Friday in September for the Spring semester and Third (3rd) Friday in January for the Fall semester.**
3. Submit a Nursing Application to the Associate Degree Nursing Program by the **Third (3rd) Friday in September for the Spring semester and Third (3rd) Friday in January for the Fall semester.**
4. Submit a Copy of **LPN License, CPR Card, Proof of Graduation from PN Program, Valid Picture ID.**
5. Complete a **Criminal Background Clearance** check from Global Investigative Services, 1109 Spring Street, Suite 401, Silver Spring, MD 20910. Phone: (301)589-0088
6. *Meet the Pre-Nursing Requirements for the University of the District of Columbia Community College (UDCCC)
7. If you have taken college courses at another College or University, have your official transcript submitted to UDCCC.

*All LPN students accepted in the Accelerated LPN-RN Program at UDC must have completed Pharmacology prior to starting the first semester of the LPN-RN Accelerated Nursing Program. Students who choose to do the Pharmacology Course at UDC (or any other school) must be aware that completion of the course (or taking the course at UDC) will not mean automatic acceptance into the Accelerated LPN-RN Associate Degree Program. **All LPN students must pay the current Credit by Examination FEES prior to Graduation Clearance. The Board of Trustees waived the tuition for the Escrow Credits awarded upon successful completion of the LPN Validation Theory/Laboratory course.**
